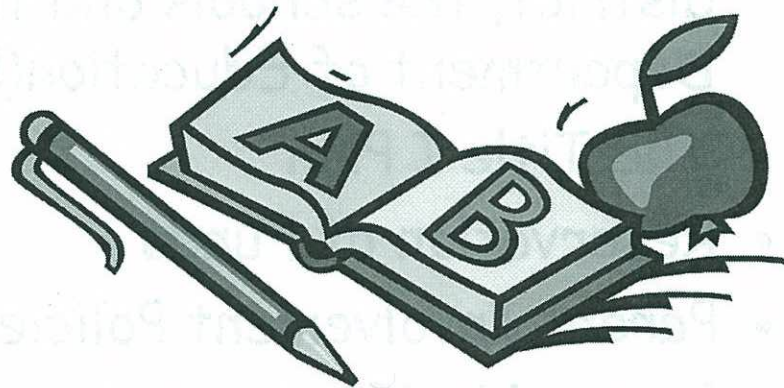

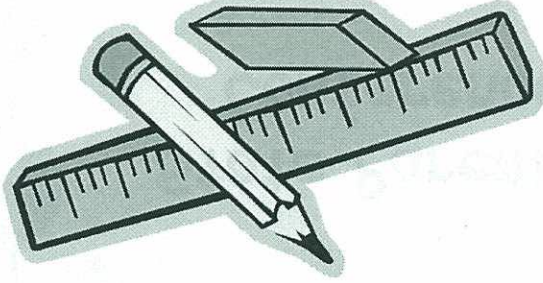

NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND(NCLB)

DEFINITION OF PARENT INVOLVEMENT

- o NCLB defines parental involvement as the participation of parents in **regular, two-way and meaningful** communication involving student academic learning and other school activities, ensuring:
 - that parents play an integral role in assisting their child's learning;
 - that parents are encouraged to be actively involved in their child's education at school;
 - that parents are full partners in their child's education and are included, as appropriate, in decision-making and on advisory communities to assist in the education of their child; and
 - that other activities are carried out, such as those described in section 1118 of NCLB (Parental Involvement).

NCLB MANDATES PARENT INVOLVEMENT

- o NCLB provides provisions for parents to be involved in the education of their children.
 - These provisions provide a good foundation to engage families in the education process which in turn helps them educate their children. Student's progress improves when their parents are actively involved, both at home and at school.
- o Section 1118 provides policies to increase parent involvement at various levels.
