

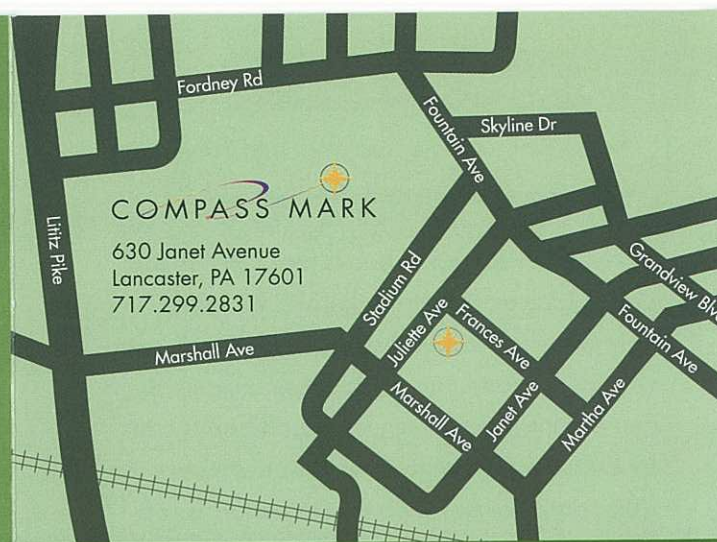
TRAINING AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE
