

Casino Night!

- Dice:
 - Roll two dice and create simple addition problems ($4+3=7$)
 - Roll two dice and create larger addition problems ($52+24=76$)
 - Roll three (or more) dice to create 3 digit numbers
- Probability with spinner
 - Create your own spinner with paper, a pencil or pen, and a paper clip
 - Record number of times that the spinner lands on each section.
- Penny flip
 - Count and record number of heads and tails
- Poker chips with numbers/letters
 - Grab two, three, or four chips and add the numbers
 - Take 3 chips and make the largest 3 digit number
 - Write letters on a set of poker chips for spelling practice
 - Pull out a chip and find things around the house beginning with that letter
 - Practice basic consonant-vowel-consonant words with letter chips for blending
- Coin exchange games
- Cards
 - One-to-One Match: Match a number of objects to the number on the card.
 - Go Fish...for Sets of Ten!
 - Math Facts
 - Place Value: Draw four cards and make the greatest number or smallest number.
 - Range, Median, and Mode
 - Greater Than and Less Than: Make an alligator mouth for fun!
 - Balancing Equations: Draw 2 cards and add. Leave to one side. Draw another card. Determine which number would balance the equations.
 - Complete the Fact

- Salute: Two players hold one card on their forehead without looking. A third player announces the sum of the two cards. Based on the other player's card and the sum, each player guesses the card on their head.

Glow in the Dark Night!

- Glow sticks
 - Use sticks to form letters and words
 - Use sticks to form numbers
 - Create math problems
 - Counting practice
 - Create patterns with colored glow sticks
 - Place a thin glow stick inside a beach ball or balloon
 - On outside of ball:
 - Story retelling
 - Math facts
 - Sight words
- Tic Tac Glow – to get the box, you have to read a word, fluency phrase, math fact, etc.
- Glow slime
 - solid, liquid, or gas
 - form letters and numbers
- Constellation activities
 - find, create, describe
- Glow bubbles – use with index cards sight words, questions, or facts
- Glow in the dark water balloons – fill balloons with water and add a glow stick
- Read *The Very Lonely Firefly* by Eric Carle – mini-stations about bioluminescent animals – record facts
- Glow chalk – read/write a how to story for recipe, make, use outside to write words or math facts
